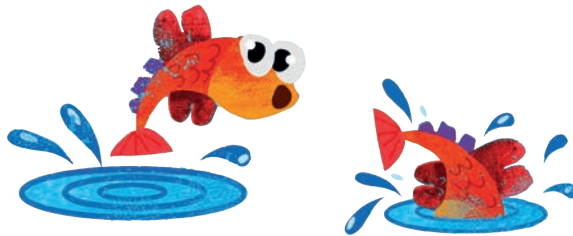




Look Out! Hungry Snake by Paul Delaney
