Let's make a Lollipop Stick Character

#### You will need:

- Card or thick paper
- a printer
- scissors
- glue
- Iollipop sticks
- a grown-up to help with the cutting and sticking





### Instructions:

- 1. Print the activity sheets onto card or thick paper and ask a grown-up for help to cut out the pictures
- 2. Put some glue onto one end of the lollipop sticks then stick the pictures onto them
- 3. Use your newly created lollipop stick characters to follow along with the actions in the rhyme. You can even use them to create your own rhymes and stories
- 4. No printer, no problem. Create your own characters and let your imagination run wild!




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
